Salaries of a Project Manager




Interested in a career in Project Management? Want to know what your peers are earning as project managers?

- Certified individuals averaged a 16% pay increase from 2004 to 2005.

According to salary.com, project managers in the New York City area earn anywhere between \$69,000-\$115,000, depending upon their level of expertise.
